Why This Topic?

- Commonly requested
 - Parishes need money
 - Stewardship teaching in past has been limited
 - Additional \$ can help strengthen/prolong parishes

But there is more....

Effective stewardship efforts help parishioners to increase the level of meaning that the Church (Christ) has to them and their lives and to foster positive attitudes toward generosity.

"All I have comes from God. I want this parish to be best it can be. I see God's work here"



OCA Parish Life Study 2002


Percent of Parishes in Each Category Using a "Pledge System"


Average Annual Offerings Per Household


Offerings by \$ Amount

Possible Conclusions

- Parishes on pledge systems are more likely to be growing than those on dues systems.
 - No growing parishes use dues system.
 - A few parishes on pledge system are declining
- Parishes on dues systems generate far smaller donations per household than parishes on nondues systems.
- Some Orthodox Christians tithe.
- People who plan their giving, either by making a pledge or by pre -determining a percentage to contribute to the church give significantly more than those who decide what to give on a weekto-week basis.
